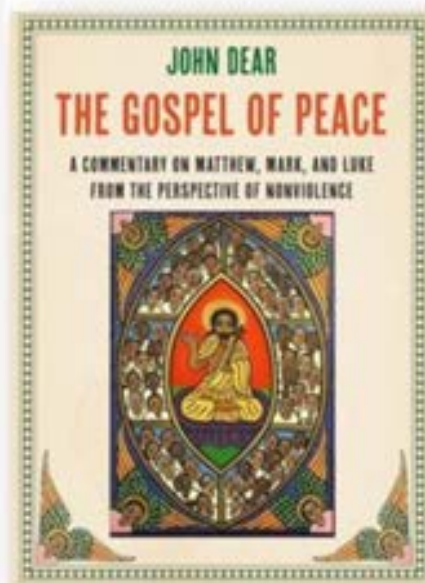
John Dear

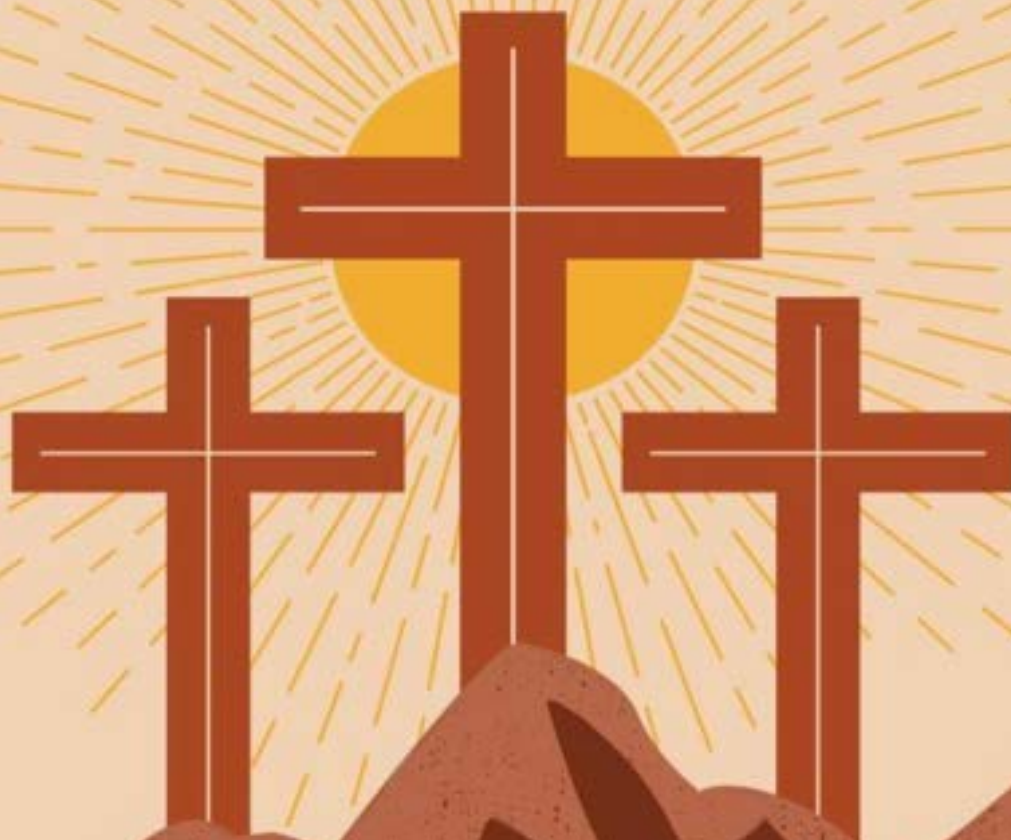
