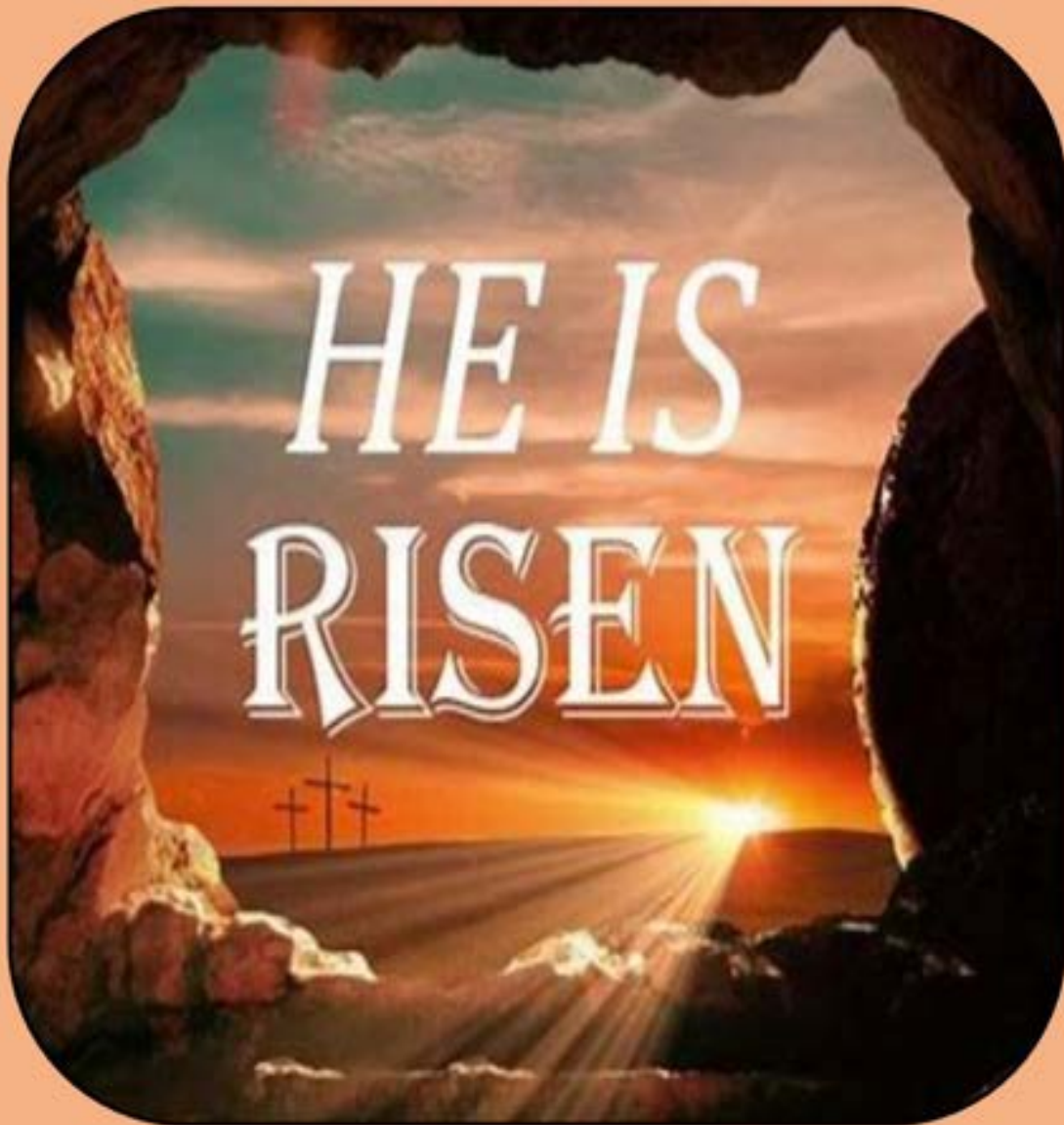

Our Mission

Keep It Movin' is a year-long church-based walking program and research study designed to decrease chronic illness and improve the overall quality of life within the African American community.

The Keep It Movin' research study is testing two approaches, **GetFit4Life** and **Stronger4Longer**, to empower communities to safely increase their daily physical activity for overall improved health.

GetFit4Life

We provide the tools needed to help participants make active lifestyle changes on their own schedules. The program at a glance:

- Self-paced GetFit4Life exercise guide
- Weekly motivational tips
- Step-by-step video demonstrations

Stronger4Longer

We provide in-person instruction to help participants make active lifestyle changes within a group setting. The program at a glance:

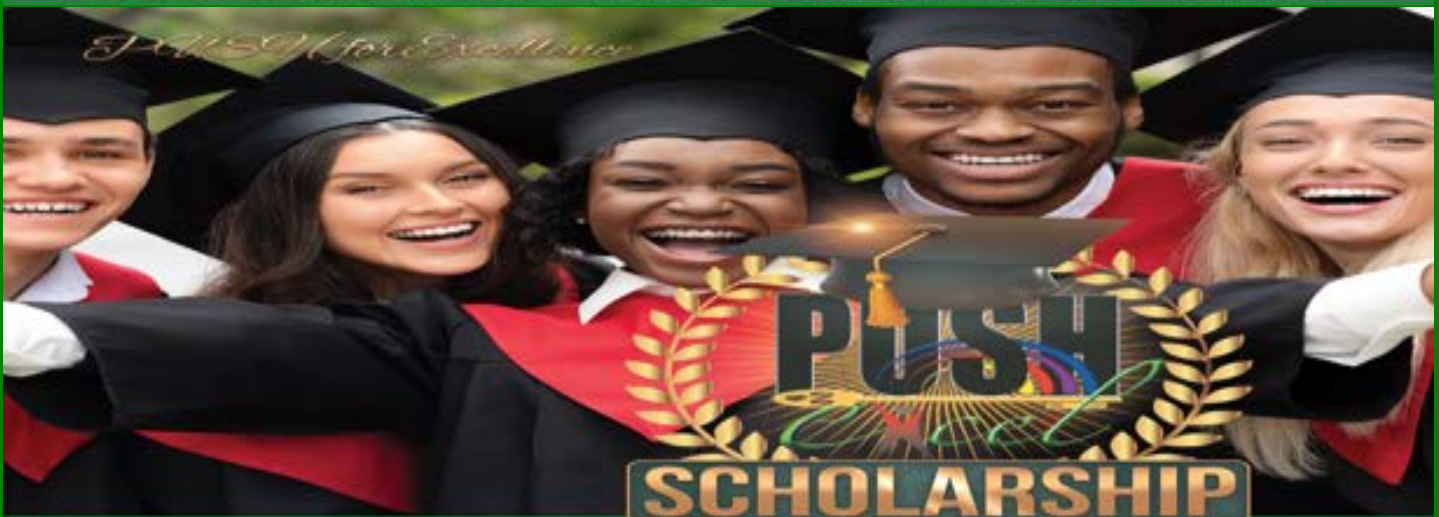
