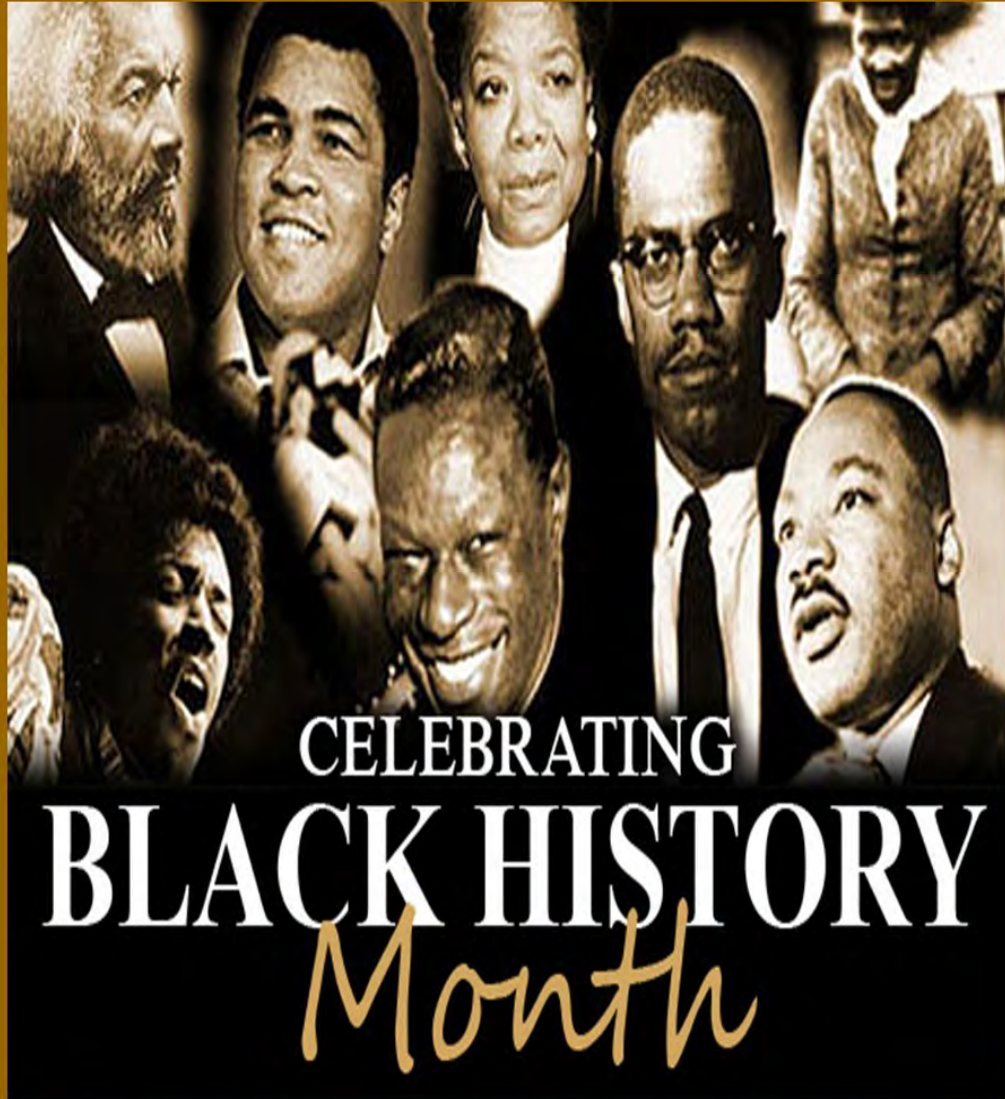

If you filled out a form, there is nothing for you to do. If you have not filled out a form you need to do so. If you are unsure, you can contact the Church Office.

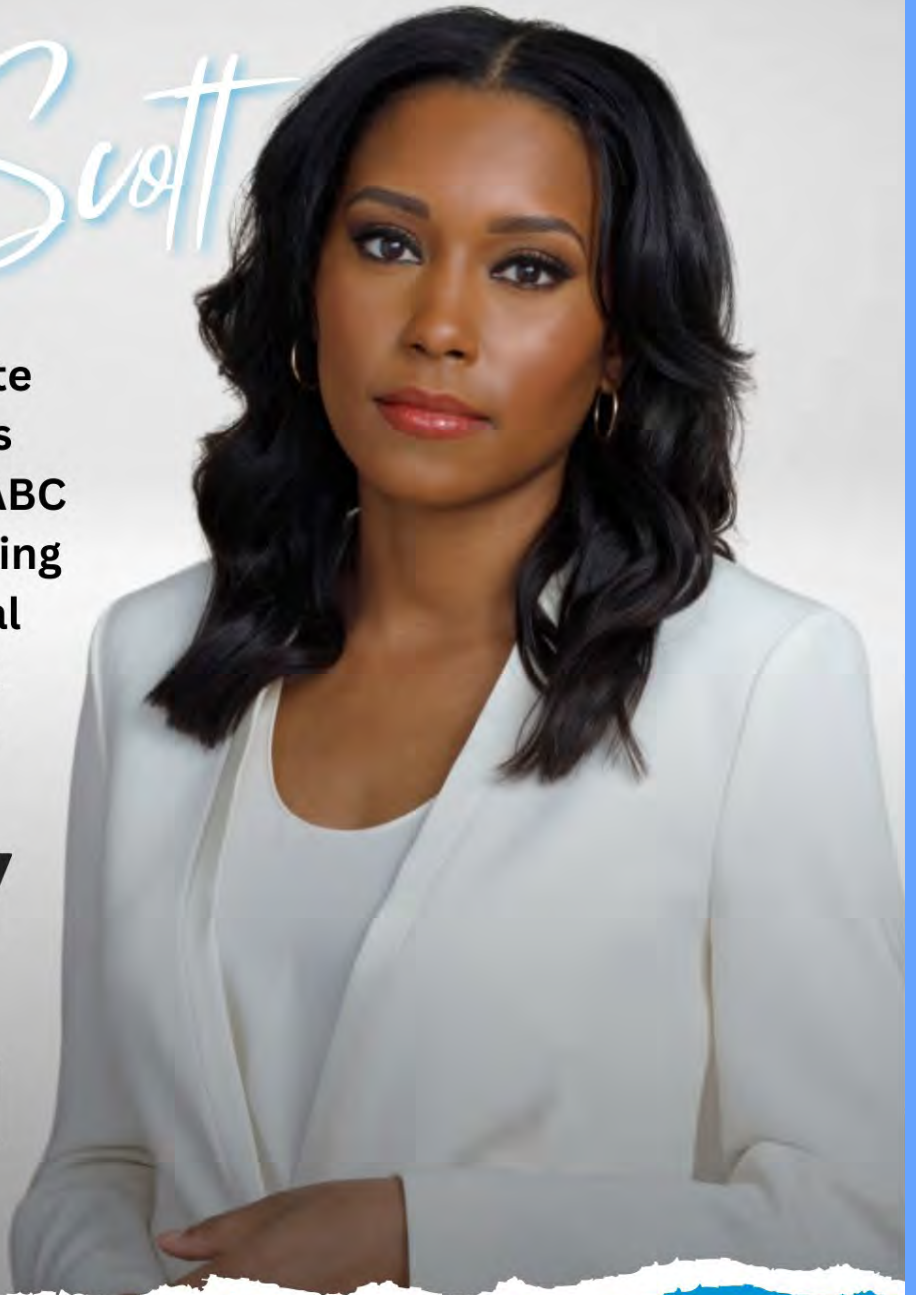

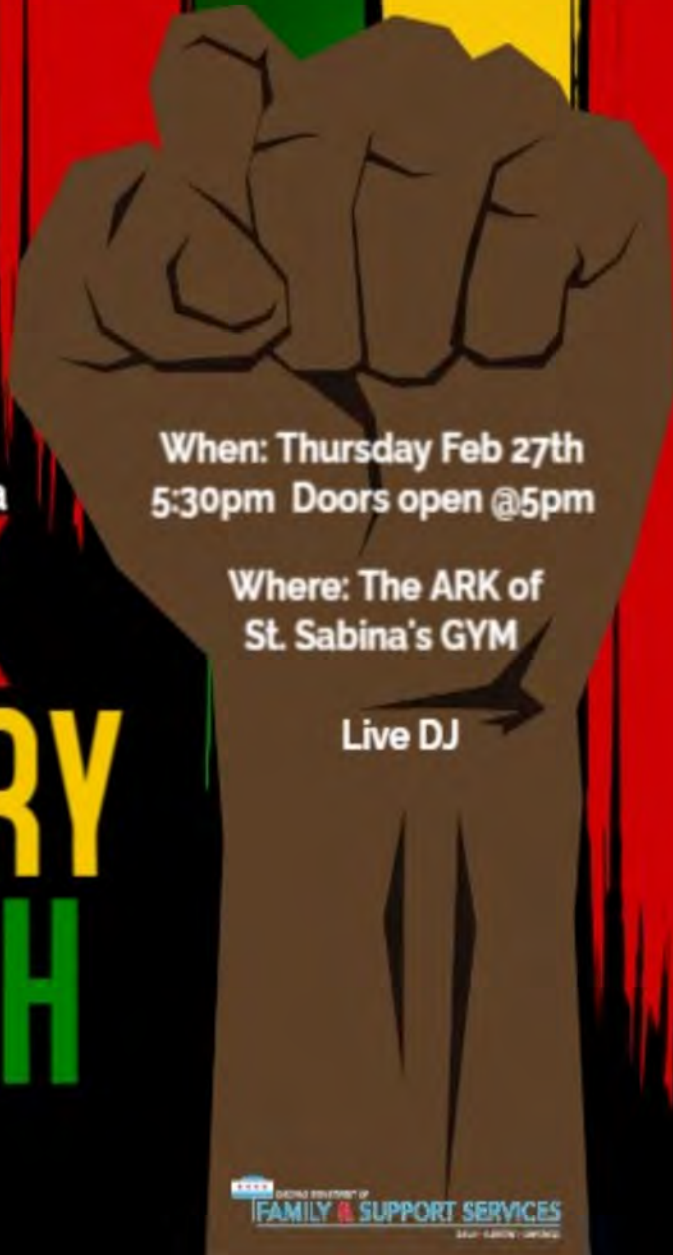

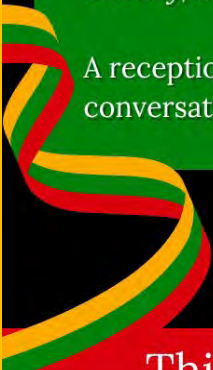
